

SPRING CURRICULUM

Unit 1: God Chooses Moses

Stories from Moses' life share how he was rescued by a princess, called by God through a burning bush, and saw God work powerfully to free His people through plagues and miraculous signs.

Unit 2: Jesus, Our Savior


SPRING CURRICULUM


