


From the Pastor



King David, before he was the actual King, came to an impasse one day when Saul had chased him all the way to the Philistine border. He felt his only recourse was to feign insanity at the gates of the city of Gath, which just happened to be the hometown of Goliath and his brothers. I'm of the persuasion that he still had 4 stones left that he carried with him at all times just in case he ran into those guys! But just imagine having to run for your life and your only viable option is to end up in the hometown of your archrival. I suppose that this is standard operating procedure for someone being trained to be the greatest King Israel has ever had.

There's another group of people that are being chased by ISIS all the way beyond their nation's borders, and these Muslim refugees are completely fed up with Islam, which has brought a real openness to the Good News about Jesus. The Assemblies of God are involved in 16,000 house churches where former Muslims have now given their lives to Christ, and I have been placed on the Founder's Board with the task of training the new believers who are leading these churches.

Global University is just now completing the translation of their Pastoral studies into Farsi, the predominant language of these refugees, and they are able to place all of these textbooks onto a kindle to be sent to these aspiring Pastors. I can't even begin to tell you how excited I am about this process. I have committed that we here at Trinity Life Center will be responsible to raise \$10,000 for the purchase of these kindles and the transfer of these textbooks into the native tongue of the precious Muslims who have now been converted to Christ, so that their house leaders can begin their Pastoral training. At the Founders meeting I recently attended, we pledged \$116,000 for this project. If anyone reading this has a passion to reach Muslims, please join me by sending a check of any amount. SERMON NOTES

Psalm 56 (NLT Translation)

¹O God, have mercy on me,
for people are hounding me.
My foes attack me all day long.
²I am constantly hounded by those who slander me,
and many are boldly attacking me.
³But when I am afraid,
I will put my trust in you.
⁴I praise God for what he has promised.
I trust in God, so why should I be afraid?
What can mere mortals do to me?
⁵They are always twisting what I say;
they spend their days plotting to harm me.
⁶They come together to spy on me—
watching my every step, eager to kill me.
⁷Don't let them get away with their wickedness;
in your anger, O God, bring them down.
⁸You keep track of all my sorrows.
You have collected all my tears in your bottle.
You have recorded each one in your book.
⁹My enemies will retreat when I call to you for help.
This I know: God is on my side!
¹⁰I praise God for what he has promised;
yes, I praise the LORD for what he has promised.
¹¹I trust in God, so why should I be afraid?
What can mere mortals do to me?
¹²I will fulfill my vows to you, O God,
and will offer a sacrifice of thanks for your help.
you have kept my feet from slipping.
So now I can walk in your presence, O God,
in your life-giving light.

1 Samuel 21:10-15 (NLT Translation)

¹⁰So David escaped from Saul and went to King Achish of Gath. ¹¹But the officers of Achish were unhappy about his being there. "Isn't this David, the king of the land?" they asked. "Isn't he the one the people honor with dances, singing,

'Saul has killed his thousands,
and David his ten thousands?'"

¹²David heard this comments and was very afraid of what King Achish of Gath might do to him. ¹³So he pretended to be insane, scratching on doors and drooling down his beard.

¹⁴Finally, King Achish said to his men, "Must you bring me a madman?"

¹⁵We already have enough of them around here! Why should I let someone like this be my guest?"
