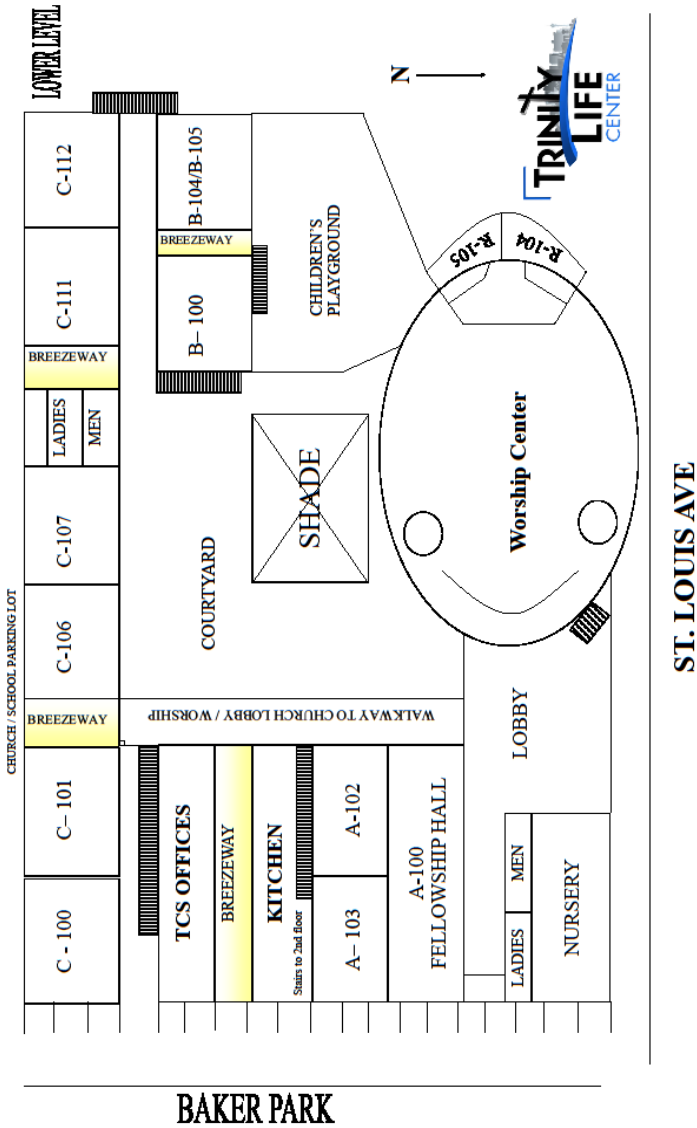

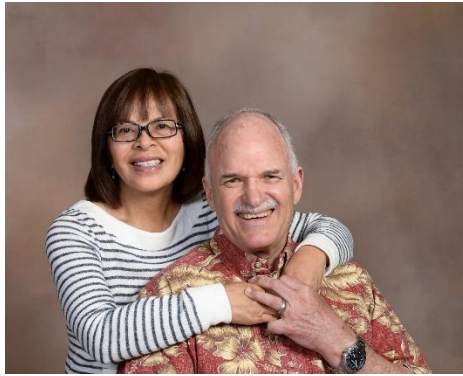
## **The Life of the Apostle Paul**

Probably the key verse for Christian apologetics is 1Peter 3:15, "But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect..." Christian apologetics is simply presenting a reasonable defense of the Christian faith and truth to those who disagree.
