Today I want to explore several things Luke wrote about concerning the incredible event where the Holy Spirit was poured out and the disciples, along with 112 others, were baptized in the Holy Spirit. PENTECOST SUNDAY

(Today we celebrate the birth of Christianity)

And, today we celebrate our first Sunday back worshipping as the corporate Body of Christ following the COVID-19 mandatory Precautionary Quarantine.

Our greatest concern is your safety and that of your family. We will be following certain guidelines as articulated by the Members of the Coronavirus Task Force.

WHILE ON OUR CHURCH CAMPUS WE ENCOURAGE ALL OF US TO PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES

- ◆ No one should plan to attend services who are known to have had any contact with known COVID-19 confirmed cases.
- ◆ Once inside the building please practice social distancing by maintaining six feet distance from others,
- ◆ Masks are not required by anyone attending service; however, we strongly suggest they be worn.
- ◆ Wash your hands before and after services.
- ◆ Stay six feet from others.
- ◆ Cover your coughs and sneeze.

- ◆ Visit hand sanitizer stations frequently.
- ◆ Don't shake hands.
- ◆ Don't hug others.
- ◆ Don't come to church if you are sick,
- ◆ Don't touch your face, nose and mouth.

ENTERING THE CAMPUS AND BUILDING

- ◆ Please follow all signage outside and inside the building.
- ◆ Please follow the directions of our staff entering and exiting the building.
- ◆ Items such as the bulletin, will be in boxes as held by staff members and you will be free to take the items from the boxes.
- ◆ The nursery and toddler's rooms will be closed until further notice.
- ◆ No coffee or food will be shared on campus.
- ◆ Please take precautions when using all church facilities. Please self-sanitize any and all areas utilized.
- ◆ Drinking fountains will be unavailable until further notice.
- ◆ Enter at the double glass doors of the main entrance (*St. Louis Avenue* and the *courtyard* entrances).
- ◆ Lobby doors will be propped open to avoid the touching of the door handles.

WHILE IN THE AUDITORIUM

- ◆ Available seating will be designated and socially distanced (front, back, left, and right).
- ◆ Families will sit together.
- ◆ Offering receptacles will be available as Pastor Randy directs. Please follow his directions.

EXITING THE BUILDING AND CAMPUS

- ◆ Please follow the directions of our staff for exiting the building.
- ◆ Lobby doors will be propped open to avoid the touching of door handles.
- ◆ We will sanitize the auditorium after each service.

SENIORS AND VULNERABLE

Because of the dangers related to COVID-19, we are asking all elderly members and members of all ages who have underlying health conditions such as breathing conditions, cancer treatments, suppressed immune systems, etc., to use extreme caution. We will continue worshipping via Livestream during the beginning stages of our return. It may be necessary to stay away from "crowds."

SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP SCHEDULE AND THROUGHOUT THE WEEK

Until further notice we will follow a weekly worship schedule as established by today's activities and boundaries. Pastor Randy will keep us informed through various channels if and when it is time to expand our activities not only on Sundays but Wednesday evening, Thursday and Friday mornings as well.
