"THE SOLUTION TO EVERY CRISIS"


Acts 2:1-13 (OG)



The Sunday we celebrate the beginning of the Church through the descent of the Holy Spirit.




The solution to the current crises, or any crisis any of us will ever face, is to be filled with the Holy Spirit.








