It's timely because Paul was giving Timothy and Titus some pretty explicit instructions on how to navigate difficult situations as a Pastor. I believe the Spirit led us this way because we all need to learn how to pastor the people we rub shoulders with, and learn how to manage the inevitable conflicts coming our way as a result of the tremendous tensions that are brewing all over the land.

Today I'm calling it "walking through minefields." Pastor Biniam walked right through a minefield and out of his country so he could experience the freedom to share Christ around the world. His pathway had to be perfectly constructed. One misstep would have taken his life.

As we navigate, it will rarely be perfect. Ministry is messy and we all make mistakes. But learning how to live together in unity, how to prefer one another and love and honor one another, especially when we disagree with each other's opinions or political views - that type of maturity is what Paul was attempting to instill in these young Pastors.

I personally, even after 40 years, have stepped on mines and unfortunately will probably continue to do so. But the key is progress not perfection. The key is maturing to the point that, even when we disagree, we continue to deeply love one another in the love of Jesus. Every ounce of this must be bathed in prayer!
