## From the Pastor



We trust that you had a beautiful Thanksgiving and are now ready to approach the Advent season, because ready or not, Advent is here and starts today! It came a little early this year, and to be respectful of what in our Church is one of the great holidays of all, Thanksgiving, we chose to wait until Thanksgiving was over and we will decorate for Christmas this coming

Tuesday at 10 am.

Hanukkah also begins tonight, the celebration of when one day of oil was supernaturally sustained for eight days during the uprising of the Maccabees, who finally stood up to the Greeks, led by Mattathias and his family, known as the Hasmoneans. They fought a guerrilla warfare, never more than 12,000 men taking on over 50,000 Greek and Syrian army troops.

I went over this in greater detail last Wednesday evening, but my favorite aspects of that story from 2200 years ago that once again sustained the Jewish culture, is that:

- 1). Maccabaeus is the Greek word for hammer, but the Jews took it and made it Jewish by declaring that it stood for the first four letters in Exodus 15:11, meaning, "Who is like You, God?" which was spoken by Moses and the people after the drowning of the Egyptian Army in the Red Sea.
- 2). That small miraculous light sustained in the Temple has led us as Judeo-Christians to the True Light that was coming, Jesus, Yeshua, the Light of the world. He is the One Who kept that Menorah burning, even though they only had one uncontaminated flask, enough to last one day, and it burned eight days until they could prepare more pure olive oil, which was the only way the Menorah could be lit.

All of that leads us to Jesus! Let's pray that the Jewish people will continue to come to know Him as well.
