Watch how much fun Jesus had by concealing His identity from these family members until He revealed Himself by breaking bread. Just imagine their astonishment and overwhelming joy as they jumped up and made the return trip to Jerusalem in record time!

I always approach Resurrection Sunday with deep wonder. The range of emotions in the lives of all who were close to Jesus had to be astonishing. But all of them lived out the rest of their lives completely devoted and never again doubting that Jesus was and is who He said He was, the Son of the Living God Who came to take away the sins of the world!
