Ahaz was a faithless slug, an unbelieving coward. He leaves a trail of slime across the priceless throne of David. It's hard to believe that this faithless, hopeless, irritating hypocrite of a king is the one who first receives the prophecy of Immanuel and the Virgin Birth of Christ.

It always astonishes me about the faithless conversation and the hypocritical and terrified context into which this horrible hypocrite received the blessed

revelation of the coming of the Messiah and the Virgin Birth.
