The Greek word 'Homo' means 'same' and the word for 'similar' is 'Homoi.' The only difference in the spelling is a jot, the smallest letter in the Greek alphabet. 'Ousias' means 'Being.' In Hebrews 1:3, there was great controversy over whether the proper translation was that Jesus was of the same substance as God or just similar—homoosias vs. homoiosias.

Constantine, the Christian Emperor of Rome, was tired of the church being divided over this issue so he called for the Nicene Council in 325 AD to settle it, and settle it they did! In fact, had they not settled it correctly, we would be in big trouble in the church today. Praise God they landed on Jesus being of the same substance as God instead of similar substance. Similar to God but not the same, less than God is what Jehovah Witnesses believe. Jesus is a god, but He's not equal with the Father, they say.

But thank God for the original Santa Claus, St. Nicolas from Turkey, who opposed and challenged a heretic named Arius. The argument became so heated that Nicolas finally punched Arius right in the face!

With that one act, the original Santa got on the naughty list, but boy was he being nice to all of us to combat that heresy as powerfully as he did. And it all hinged on a jot, the smallest letter. So next year, if you see Santa kneeling at the manger scene, that takes on greater significance than ever before due to the fact that Nicolas correctly discerned that Jesus is "the express image of His Being," not Someone who is just similar to God!

God from God, Light from Light, very God from very God, Begotten, not made, of the same essence as the Father. That's our Jesus!
