# FROM THE PASTOR



OK, which one is it? I mean, what is Hebrews 6 promoting? Does it give us its stiffest warning so far to freak us out, to scare us into never turning our backs on God? Is that the intent, or is it stirring us toward the absolute certainty of our salvation?

First it says in v4 that it's 'impossible to bring back those who were once enlightened...' It's impossible to bring back those 'who have tasted the goodness of the Word of God...who then turn away from God.'

But then in vv17- 19 we are told that 'God bound Himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that He would never change His mind. So God has given both His promise and His oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary.

It's highly possible that the writer of the book of Hebrews is using hyperbole (an exaggerated statement not to be taken literally) as a rhetorical device to stir his readers on to greater maturity. He is definitely encouraging them to not ever give up, because just look at all God has in store for us!

I believe the oath God gave us is the presence of the Holy Spirit who guarantees our inheritance. He's like our engagement ring! God's promise and God's oath are immutable. That means His will can't change. His purpose towards us will not change. It can't be switched, it can't be turned around, it cannot be altered. I truly believe that our salvation is certain and secure!
